## Looking at the Readings:

Today's first reading from the book of the Proverbs portrays God as wisdom. Human wisdom may be acquired through a lifetime of experience, education, reflection, listening to others, observing creation or as a gift of God. The Wisdom of God, as presented here is a primordial creation, and personal attribute of God, a master craftsman, a playful child. Such attributes do not compromise the one true God, undivided and at the same time acknowledged by humankind as the Trinity.

In the passage from the letter to the Romans, St Paul attests to the Trinity: the Lord Jesus who brings judgement, faith, hope, grace; God [the Father] who loves us, and that love given to us through the Holy Spirit.

Sometimes a schoolteacher concedes that class time has run out before the day's program is completed. So, when Jesus, speaking to the disciples, said "I still have many things to say to you ... but not now." he did not concede that he had run out of time but indicated the right time for more has not yet come and the teacher has not yet arrived. They need to wait for the Holy Spirit. Again, this passage attests to God as Father, the Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit working as one but each in a different way.

## Words of Pope Leo XIV

"Brothers and sisters, I would like that our first great desire be for a united Church, a sign of unity and communion, which becomes a leaven for a reconciled world. In this our time, we still see too much discord, too many wounds caused by hatred, violence, prejudice, the fear of difference, and an economic paradigm that exploits the Earth's resources and marginalises the poorest. For our part, we want to be a small leaven of unity, communion and fraternity within the world. We want to say to the world, with humility and joy: Look to Christ! Come closer to him! Welcome his word that enlightens and consoles! Listen to his offer of love and become his one family: in the one Christ, we are one".

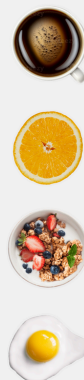

**Liturgical Jottings ~ The Trinity Song**

Fr Frank Andersen MSC released his first collection of hymns in 1978, "Eagle's Wings" subtitled Scripture in Song and published by Chevalier Press. He composed them while teaching at Daramalan, Canberra. These scripturally based hymns are very popular and singable for congregational singing.

They are based on or inspired by the Psalms, St Paul's letters, Prophets and Gospels.

The Trinity Song is not printed with a scriptural reference, like most, but every line is from scripture:

Father, in my life I see You are God who walks with me

Psalms 16:8

You hold my life in Your hands Psalm 65,

Psalm 24:1-2

Close beside You I will stand,

Psalm 23:4

I give all my life to You, Psalms 25:1 Help me to be true. Proverbs 19:1

Help me, Spirit, to be true. John 16 from today's Gospel
